CHILD PORNOGRAPHY SUSPECT BOOKED ON ADDITIONAL CHARGES

On October 11, 2008, detectives assigned to the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department's Child Abuse Bureau booked 49-year-old Jaime Enrique Feliciano (see booking photo below) on eight counts of lewd or lascivious acts involving a child. Feliciano has been in custody at the Sacramento County Main Jail since his September 9, 2008.

Feliciano was arrested after the members of the Sheriff's Department's multi-jurisdictional High-Tech Crimes/Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force received a tip that Feliciano had inappropriate contact with a juvenile in Reno, Nevada. After receiving the tip, the task force investigators carried out a compliance check at Feliciano's home, where they found thousands of pornographic images of children on his computer.

The computer also contained a video of an unidentified child being molested. In an effort to identify the child, ICAC investigators spent hundreds of hours completing a forensic examination of Feliciano's computer. As a result of the examination investigators were able to identify the, now 9-year-old, child. Child Abuse Bureau detectives then located and interviewed both the child and the child's mother which led to filing of the additional charges.

Detectives believe Feliciano may have victimized other children and urge anyone who has information, or concerns, about Jaime Feliciano's inappropriate contact/conduct with children to call the Sheriff's Department at (916) 874-5115.

Feliciano's bail has been set at \$800,000.00. He is scheduled to be arraigned on the new charges on October 10, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. in Department 61.
